Family Living and Community Relationships	FLE 8.5	<p><b><i>The student will successfully complete a project, which requires application of the identified needs of the older generation.</i></b>            The student will investigate issues related to the aging process. Simulation activities related to health problems of the aged are used.</p>
	FLE 8.6	<p><b><i>The student will identify a community problem important to him or her and plan and execute a course of action to correct the problem.</i></b>            Students select a community problem such as community littering, recycling issues, vandalism, housing for the elderly, or increasing drug abuse awareness to analyze and then develop a plan for addressing it.</p>
Parenting Skills	FLE 8.43	<p><b><i>The student will review safety hazards associated with child care when one is alone and recall emergency procedures he or she should follow.</i></b>            Safety hazards associated with baby-sitting siblings and others are reviewed. Emergency simulation activities are used to reinforce emergency procedures.</p>
	FLE 8.44	<p><b><i>The student will be prepared to provide age-appropriate activities for young children 0-10 years of age.</i></b>            Students will review characteristics of children from newborn to age ten. A variety of games, songs, books, toys, and activities are examined.</p>
