“Expressive Arts for Individuals with Disabilities”

The study and appreciation of the expressive arts (dance/movement, drama, music, fine arts) allows individuals with disabilities to appreciate who they are, how they see themselves, and how they can relate to the world around them. Through expressive arts, persons with disabilities find the confidence to be themselves through self-exploration, increasing their social interaction in the community, and experiencing artistic and creative stimulation for a sense of creativity and personal satisfaction. This workshop will be highly interactive in its discussion of the expressive arts with an emphasis on movement. Workshop presenter Tommy McNeal is a gifted and nationally-renowned theatrical performer who developed his “Expressive Arts Outreach” Program to enable individuals with disabilities to overcome boundaries and work through emotions to gain a better awareness of themselves and the gifts they possess.
