Hands-on inquiry is essential for the mastery of scientific principles. During a science lesson, students use different types of materials and equipment. Every student has a right to be in a safe and productive learning environment. Prior to conducting any science activities, the attached rules must be signed by students and their parents/guardians.

Science Rules

- 1. I will be a responsible scientist!
- 2. I will only do science activities at home when supervised by an adult.
- 3. I will listen carefully and follow all written and oral directions.
- 4. I will ask questions when I do not understand something.
- 5. I will not touch or play with any science materials without permission.
- 6. I will keep myself and others safe.
- 7. I will keep my hands away from my face, eyes, and mouth.
- 8. I will wash my hands often.
- 9. I will keep my area clean and throw away materials as directed.
- 10.1 will not remove science materials from the classroom.
- 11. I will tell an adult if I see something or someone being unsafe.
- 12. I will be careful if I am using any sharp objects, like scissors or glassware.
- 13.1 will not touch, taste, eat, drink, or smell anything used in a science activity unless an adult tells me to do so.
- 14. I will wear and use any safety equipment as directed by an adult.
