Investigating with My Five Senses – Science Safety Rules

- I will always be safe and tell an adult if I see something that is not safe.
- I will wear safety clothes or glasses.
- I will clean up and wash my hands when directed.
- I will not touch, taste, eat, drink, or smell anything used in a science activity without permission.
- I will not touch my face, eyes, and mouth during science activities.
