REGISTRATION TIPS!

Be prepared before registration starts

- ♦ **Check your account:** Do you already have an ACTIVENet account? [Click here to sign in](#) and make sure your information is up to date.
- ♦ **Create an account:** If you do not have an ACTIVENet account, [click here to create one](#).
- ♦ **Check our ACTIVENet FAQs:** Need help creating an account or updating your information? [Check out our FAQs](#) for more information.
- ♦ **Find your camp(s):** Visit the [camps section on ACTIVENet](#) to find your selections.
- ♦ **Add family members to your account:**
 1. You may add a family member while submitting your head of household account information, by clicking on the Submit and Add Family Member link.
 2. You may add a family member under My Account, this is done by clicking the link Change Information About Family Members.
 3. You may also add a family member during the enrollment process. This is done by clicking on the link Add Family Member which is located beside the Participant box.
- ♦ **Complete emergency contact forms:** If this is your first time registering for a camp at our facility or if some information has changed, be sure to complete an [emergency contact form](#) for each registrant.
- ♦ **Make sure authorized picks up are up to date:** During registration, you will be required to select at least two people (18+ years of age) as authorized pick-ups. When your camper is picked up, we will check IDs against this list. Please make sure this list is up to date, including family/friends/neighbors that might be picking up.

- ♦ **Early drop off and late pick up:** New for our summer camps this year is early drop off (as early as 8 a.m.) and late pick up (as late as 6 p.m.). If you are interested in either, you are able to make that selection(s) during the registration process.
- ♦ **Add to your wish list:** Before registration opens, you can add a camp(s) to your wish list by clicking the heart next to the activity name:

Refunds: Requests made more than 14 days before the day of the camp (or first day of the camp for multi-day camps) will be refunded in full. Requests less than 14 days before the start of camp will receive a 50% refund.

- ♦ **Multi-child discounts:** When registering more than one child in the same household in the same activity, each child will receive a \$15 discount on the registration fee.

- ♦ **PWCS Employee Discount:** Current PWCS employees will receive a 10% discount on all camp registrations. To receive the discount code, employees must visit the listed URL, complete the form, and the code will be emailed to them. The form can only be accessed by current PWCS employees. NOTE: This discount cannot be combined with the multi-child discount.
