Shutdown Checklist

- ✓ Turn off all computers, monitors, speakers, printers, projectors, interactive whiteboards, and copiers.
- ✓ Clean out and unplug small refrigerators, microwaves, coffee makers, and other small appliances that can be unplugged without damage.
- ✓ Where possible, unplug TVs, VCRs, DVD players, and any other electronics.
- ✓ Where possible, set individual thermostats to 60 degrees, AUTO, and heating.
- ✓ Close windows and blinds.
- ✓ Last out, lights off.
