Shutdown Checklist

- ✓ Where possible, consolidate contents of reach-in refrigerator to walk-in, and unplug.
- ✓ Do not consolidate if unable to unplug reach-in.
- ✓ Turn off and unplug microwaves, coffee makers, and other small appliances.
- ✓ Empty and unplug all milk boxes and beverage dispensers.
- ✓ Turn off all exhaust fans, hoods, and kitchen and office lights.
- ✓ Turn off monitors, speakers, and printers*.
- ✓ Turn off all running water.
- ✓ Turn off dishwasher booster heaters.

*Leave computers on for IT system maintenance
