Additionally, the SSAC is to further enhance the working relationship between Prince William County Public Schools (PWCS), other governmental agencies, and the community, on topics that relate to the safety of students, staff, and schools, within the scope of existing School Board policies and Division regulations and to serve as a review committee for specific audits and safety related reports as deemed appropriate. Such reviews shall not include information pertaining to specific students (refer to bylaws for full scope of the SSAC).</p>
