### Drowning: An Epidemic

- Drowning is the second leading cause of death for children under the age of 14<sup>1</sup>.
- 79% of children in households with incomes less than \$50,000 have little-to-no swimming ability<sup>2</sup>.
- 64% of African American, 45% of Hispanic/Latino, and 40% of Caucasian children have little to no swimming ability<sup>2</sup>.

#### Our Solution: Water Safety School

- Our goal is to provide second grade students with instruction in swimming and water safety.
- Formal swimming lessons reduce the likelihood of childhood drowning by 88%<sup>1</sup>.







- Employee membership discounts.














#### Water Safety School and More...
