Shutdown Checklist

- ✓ Turn off all interior facility lights; double-check that lights are off in classrooms and offices.
- ✓ Shut outside doors and windows, close blinds; double-check doors, windows, and blinds in classrooms and offices.
- ✓ Unplug break room appliances (microwaves, coffee makers, toasters, etc.).
- ✓ Power down computers, monitors, printers, and copiers.
- ✓ Prop open bathroom doors and open cabinet doors with plumbing access.
- ✓ Turn off all running water.
