The 2022 monthly premium for this plan is \$251.35 per person, per month.

Prince William County Public Schools requires all its members, including retirees, beneficiaries, spouses, and children, covered under a Prince William County Public Schools retiree medical plan to enroll in Medicare Part B through Social Security Administration at the time you become eligible for Medicare Part A. Once enrolled in Medicare Part B, you must remain enrolled in order to continue receiving the maximum possible benefits.

Drug coverage is included with your plan

Part D prescription drug coverage is included in our Kaiser Permanente Medicare Advantage plans.

When you order prescription refills from a Kaiser Permanente pharmacy or online at **kp.org**, you can use the preferred prescription home delivery option for many drugs and have them sent to your home at no extra charge.

Initial coverage stage

You pay the copays and coinsurance shown in the chart on page 7 until your total yearly drug costs reach **\$7,050**. (Total yearly drug costs are the amounts paid by both you and any Part D plan during a calendar year.) If you reach the \$7,050 limit, you move on to the catastrophic stage and your coverage changes. There is not a coverage gap with the Kaiser Permanente Medicare Advantage plan.

TRANSFERRING PRESCRIPTIONS

We have two ways to help you transfer your prescriptions from your current pharmacy to a Kaiser Permanente pharmacy:

- The name and telephone number of your current pharmacy

Catastrophic coverage stage

After your yearly out-of-pocket drug costs (including drugs purchased through your retail pharmacy and through mail order) reach \$7,050, you pay:

- Generic drugs \$2
- Brand drugs \$7.50
- Vaccines \$0

Coverage beyond Original Medicare

Kaiser Permanente Medicare Advantage offers you all the services and benefits covered by Original Medicare, plus additional benefits, such as:

- The Silver&Fit[®] Healthy Aging and Exercise Program⁴ We've included the following with your Kaiser Permanente Medicare health plan:
 - » **Fitness center membership.** Reshape your life with membership at a local participating Silver&Fit fitness center. Visit **SilverandFit.com** to find a fitness center near you.
 - » Home fitness program. Members may choose two⁵ traditional home fitness kits—which may include an instruction DVD and printed guide—and effective 1/1/21, one Stay Fit kit with your choice of a FitBit[®] device, Garmin[®] device, yoga kit, or strength exercise kit. This benefit also includes website access, online fitness workout classes, educational tools, and a rewards program. • Preventive dental care

You pay a \$30 copayment for each preventive care office visit, which includes up to two oral exams, two cleanings, and two bitewing X-rays every year. Other covered dental services are provided at a reduced fee.

• Routine eye care

Your benefits include coverage for routine eye exams, glaucoma and cataract screenings, and a \$200 allowance every 24 months on glasses and contact lenses. Optical locations are conveniently located in many of our medical centers.

• Transportation to medical appointments

Our plan includes 24 rides⁶ for nonurgent medical appointments at Kaiser Permanente medical centers and contracted facilities at no extra cost.

• Virtual care options⁷

Our flexible virtual care options help you visit with your Kaiser Permanente doctor by phone or video from the comfort of home. You can also call our 24/7 advice line and email your Kaiser Permanente doctor with nonurgent questions.

• BrainHQ

Online brain health exercises are included with your membership at no extra cost. These exercises can help improve cognitive function, including memory, attention, and processing speed.

• Worldwide emergency care

You can also call Member Services at **1-888-777-5536** (TTY **711**), 7 days a week, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Kaiser Permanente is an HMO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in Kaiser Permanente depends on contract renewal. You must reside in the Kaiser Permanente Medicare health plan service area in which you enroll.
