General Information

Each graduate course costs \$1290 for Virginia educators, but you can receive a \$600 discount per semester when taking courses needed for licensure.

All courses are offered online - asynchronous or synchronous one night a week via Zoom.

Apply anytime as we have rolling admissions.

Summer 2021 sessions begin May 17; Fall semester begins August 23.

Master's Degree with Coursework for Licensure Option

- Gain your Master of Science Degree in Special Education with coursework for licensure in Special Education, General Curriculum K-12
- 10 required courses taken over 1.5 - 2 years.
- Previous graduate courses taken at accredited schools may transfer.
