Start the Conversation

Talk about AI as part of everyday life. Ask your child what tools they use and what they like about them. Explore AI tools yourself to make discussions natural and engaging.



Encourage Responsible AI Use

AI is a tool for learning and creativity, but it comes with responsibilities. Remind your child to:

- Watch for misinformation
- Protect privacy
- Follow classroom rules
- Maintain academic integrity



Educate About AI's Risks

Explain that AI isn't always correct and can be biased. Discuss risks of misinformation and how AI can be misused to deceive or influence.



Empower Critical Thinking

Help your child be an active thinker. Encourage questions and show how to cross-check AI responses with trusted sources.



Protect Privacy

Some AI tools collect personal data. Remind your child never to share personal details like names, addresses, or health information.
