Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Score Release Opt-Out Form

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Each year, PWCS high schools administer the ASVAB Career Exploration Program (CEP). The ASVAB CEP helps students better understand themselves, explore occupations that align with their interests and skills, and develop strategies to support their educational and career goals.

The assessment provides an Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) score that may help students explore career options; however, participation does **not** require military service.

Opting Out of ASVAB Score Release:

- Submitting this form requests that your student's ASVAB scores not be released to military recruiting services.
- Students must also select the option to decline release of their ASVAB scores to military recruiters when prompted during testing.
- Completing both steps ensures ASVAB score information is not shared.

Important ESSA Clarification:

- The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) separately requires school divisions to provide military recruiters access to student directory information unless a parent/guardian submits an ESSA military recruiter opt-out request through the PWCS Annual Back to School Packet.
- This form applies only to the ASVAB test score release.
- Submitting this ASVAB Score Release Opt-Out Form does not opt your student out of directory information release under ESSA.

Students may still be contacted by military recruiters through directory information unless a separate ESSA military recruiter opt-out request is submitted through the PWCS Annual Back to School Packet in ParentVUE.

Please submit this form to your school counseling department at least one week before the proctored ASVAB CEP for processing.
